

Virtual Teen-Led Crafts

Do you feel creative AND want to earn volunteer hours? We assemble weekly or bi-weekly Take and Make crafts/activities for teens. If you'd like to help us create a Take-and-Make, you'll need to submit a supplies list (enough to create 100 kits with a budget of \$50-\$75 total), step-by-step instructions (for an included instructions sheet), and a how-to/walk-through instruction video (a link will be provided on the instruction sheet).
