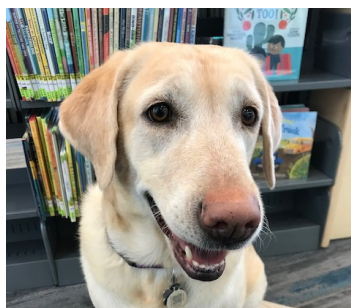
Purposeful Play- Bilingual Play Group

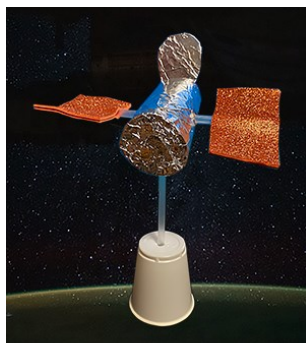
