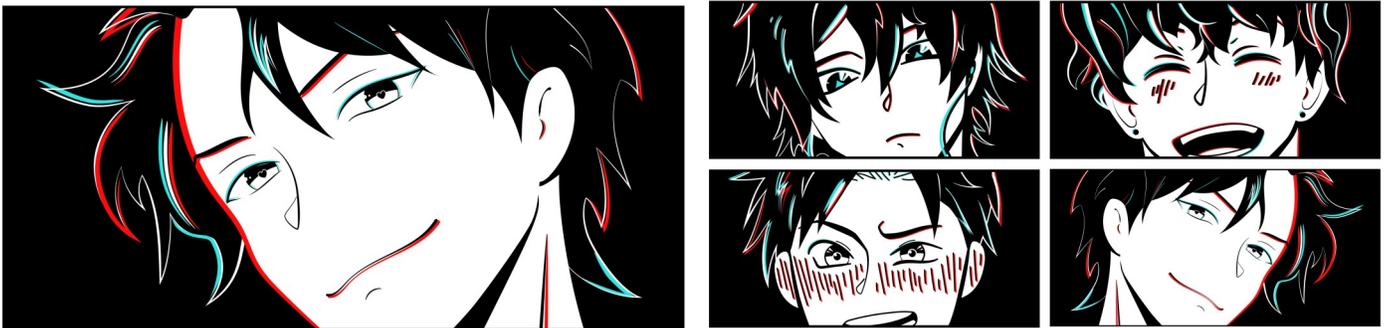
VELMA TEAGUE LIBRARY
