Come to the library to explore library 3D printing! Learn new skills and create your very own 3D printed object. **Please register! This program is for teens 12 - 18 y.o.**

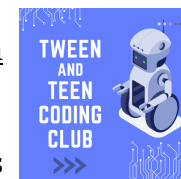


5/12 @ 2pm—4 pm. Virtual Reality Afternoon: Have you seen the new virtual reality technology and wanted to give it a
